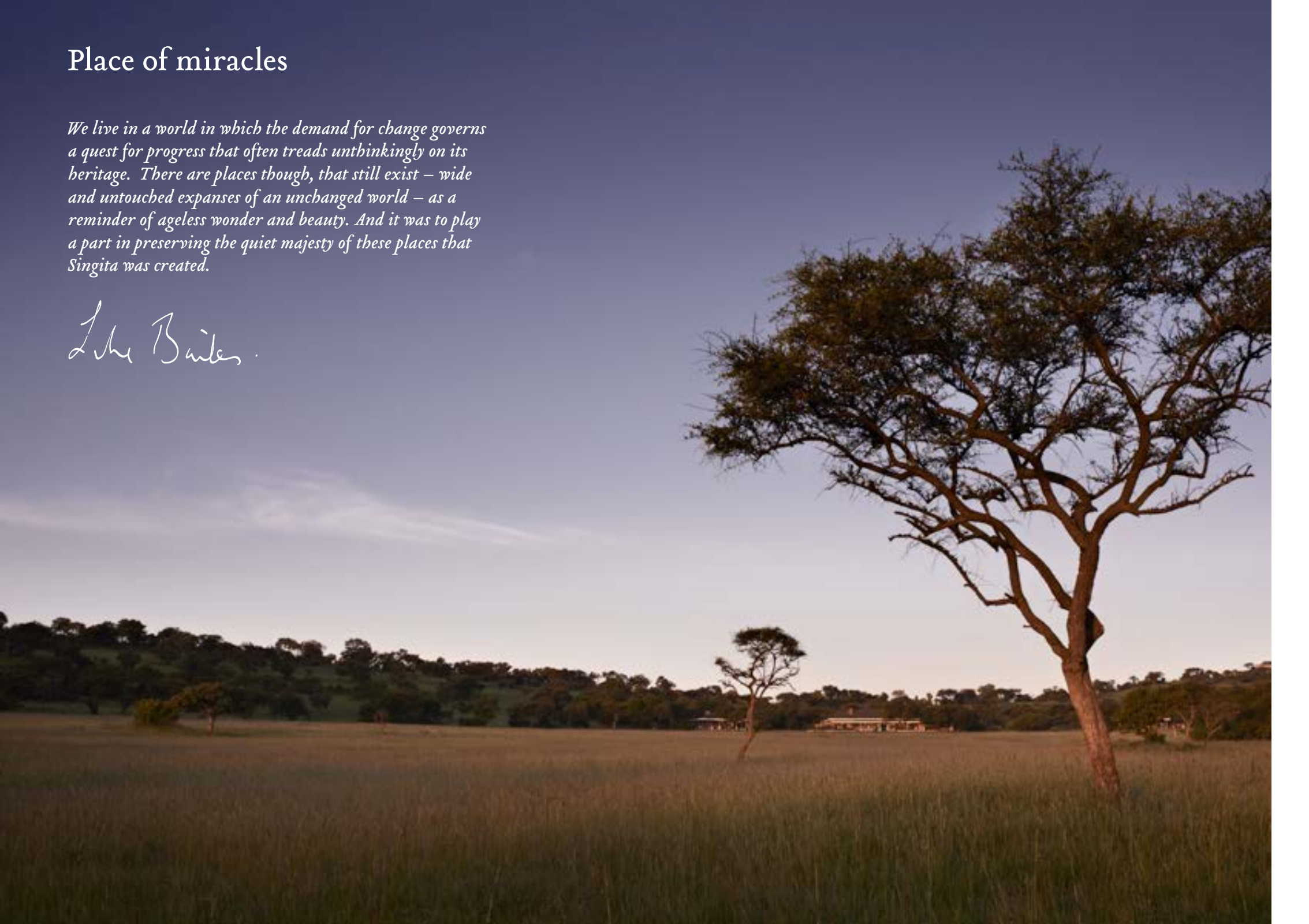
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Place of miracles

Singita Grumeti

Location of Singita Grumeti [A]

Spanning over 350,000 acres of untouched wilderness, Singita Grumeti is located in northern Tanzania, forming part of the Serengeti Mara ecosystem. Singita Serengeti House is ideally positioned on the renowned migratory route traversed annually by more than a million wildebeest.

Location of Singita Serengeti House [B]

Singita Serengeti House is a welcoming exclusive-use retreat for families and friends offering private, carefree relaxation in a home-like atmosphere. Resting on the south-east slopes of Sasakwa Hill in the 350,000-acre Singita Grumeti Reserves, the house overlooks a watering hole frequented by a variety of animals throughout the day.

Infused with an authentic African soul, this is a space of contemporary refinement and calm appeal. Humble materials are elevated into glamorous pieces through bold proportions and seductive comfort. Filled with light, reflecting the blonde shades of the Serengeti plains beyond, the palette throughout is pale and pretty, bringing the 'outside in'.



What you need to know

Best time to go on Safari

East Africa is equatorial so the climate is fairly constant and it is a year-round destination. Tanzania has a light rain season from November to March. This period is known as the 'short rains', often no more than a quick downpour each day, followed by clear sunshine. From December to March the weather becomes increasingly warmer with the 'long rains' occurring between April and May.

Seasonal Temperatures

	Average Maximum	29°C	84°F

The above temperatures are the monthly average. The absolute temperatures differ from these temperatures.

Your Packing Guide

Cotton clothing in neutral colours is recommended for game drives and bush walks. It is advisable to avoid white and dark colours as they tend to attract certain bugs. No formal wear is required at any of our lodges.

Seasons dictate comfort and comfort dictates clothing, so we recommend that you pack as follows:

- October – April: Casual summer clothes (shorts and cool shirts) and a light sweater/fleece for the cooler morning and evening temperatures
- May – September: Casual light clothing and a light sweater/fleece for the cooler mornings and nights

It is a good idea to bring along the following items for a carefree safari:

- Comfortable walking shoes/track shoes/hiking boots for walks; and sandals to wear around the house
- Swimming costume/bathing suits, sun block, sun hat, sunglasses, lip balm, mosquito repellent. (The latter two items are provided but you are welcome to bring along your favourite brand)
- Video camera, camera, binoculars, spare memory cards

Please note that in the event of rain during a game drive, waterproof ponchos will be provided.

What you need to know

Health Requirements

Singita Serengeti House is in a malarial zone so it is essential to consider taking appropriate prophylactics. Yellow fever is present in Tanzania and inoculations are compulsory prior to entering East Africa. We recommend that you consult your doctor/physician before travelling.

Accommodation

- 2 x suites located in the main house
- 2 x suites located on either side of the main house

Amenities and Services

- There is a 25m infinity swimming pool in front of the main house
- In-room spa facilities at the house or at nearby Singita Sasakwa Lodge Spa
- The Singita Boutique & Gallery at nearby Singita Sasakwa Lodge
- Each suite has a television
- Dependent upon area coverage, there is mobile phone signal
- Complementary WiFi internet is available at the house
- Electricity/power available: 220V. Converters are also available and hair dryers are supplied in each suite
- Children of all ages are welcome. There are baby-sitting services available and tailor-made activities to suit each family. Children's participation in game activities is at the discretion of your guide
- Please note that there are no Kosher or Halaal facilities available at Singita Serengeti House

Activities

- Game drives with professional guides
- Private tennis court available for use by guests
- Archery facilities and board games available for guests

- Visits to the Environmental Education Centre that was developed for the young people of our local communities
- The Equestrian Centre, situated adjacent to nearby Singita Sasakwa Lodge. There are 18 horses available for intermediate and advanced riders. Outrides on the plains available to experienced riders

Your Journey To Reach Us

By Air

- We can arrange scheduled flights or private charters for your trip. All flights land at Singita's airstrip located 10 minutes from the house
- On scheduled flights, the weight of luggage is restricted to 20kg (44lb) for checked baggage and 5kg (11lb) for hand luggage

Kilimanjaro – Singita: approximately 2 hours, 15 minutes

Arusha – Singita: approximately 2 hours

Private aircraft pilots land at their own risk and are advised to broadcast their intentions on frequency VHF channel 118.45. Planes that can land at Singita's airstrip: Beechcraft 1900; King Air; Cessna 406, 402, 404; Twin Otter and Grand Caravan.
